


Dear Mr. John Smith:

You have undergone a Colonoscopy procedure performed by Dr. William Fambord. The summary conclusions and images from the procedure include the following:

Summary:

- Moderately severe diverticulosis (562.10) found in the sigmoid colon.
- A single large sessile polyp was found in the ileocecal valve (211.3); removed by hot biopsy polypectomy. Chromoscopy procedure performed.



Please note the potential after effects documented in the attached Discharge Instructions sheet that you reviewed prior to the procedure.

Recommendations:

- Avoid all non-steroidal anti-inflammatory drugs (NSAID's) including but not limited to Ibuprofen, Advil, Motrin, and Nuprin for 5 days.
- Discharge home when standard parameters are met.
- Start high fiber diet.
- Colonoscopy recommended in 1 year. Patient to schedule a future appointment today.
- Follow-up on the results of the biopsy specimens in 1 week.
