MedPresence Embedded

Systems configured with MedPresence software are provided with the ability to take part in MedPresence meetings with two-way communication and screen sharing. The system may be configured to automatically begin a MedPresence meeting on start up. If the system is not setup to automatically begin a MedPresence meeting: Select the green MedPresence **"Begin Meeting"** button on the nCare user interface.

MedPresence Embedded Using An iOS or Android™ Device

Users may connect to a MedPresence meeting using an iPhone[®], iPad[®] or Android device.

If you are in the room and want access to voice and telestration features by following these steps:

- 1. Open the MedPresence Mobile App
- 2. Pointing the camera at the QR code on the nCare user interface
- 3. The user's device will automatically connect to the MedPresence session.

When asked to join as a remote participant outside the room, follow these steps:

- 1. Open the MedPresence Mobile app
- 2. Select department, then specialty, and press the join button to access the appropriate session/room
- 3. The user's device will automatically connect to the MedPresence session.



MedPresence Embedded Using A PC or Mac

For detailed instructions on using MedPresence refer to the MedPresence User Guide. Users may connect to a MedPresence meeting by following these steps:

- 1. Navigate to the MedPresence Web Portal (e.g. https://cityhospital.medpresence.com).
- 2. Login.
- 3. Select a Department and Specialty.
- 4. Select a Specialty.
- 5. Selecting the green "Join" button associated with the intended meeting.
- 6. The MedPresence Remote Access UI will be displayed.
- 7. Users will be able to use the MedPresence Remote Access tools to create annotations.
- 8. In most cases the meeting initiator will need to provide Remote Control permissions before users have access to any MedPresence capabilities.
